



LOS ANGELES UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT (LAUSD):

Achieving 100% Clean Renewable Energy by 2040

LAUSD designed a pathway to achieve 100% clean, renewable energy in its electricity sector by 2030, and in all energy sectors by 2040, by launching a task force of internal and external stakeholders, increasing its clean electricity from 19MW to 345MW, and more.

Expects \$20 million annual cost savings from displaced fossil fuels, and more than 400 thousand metric tons of CO₂ annually

More than 25 school sites currently undergoing technical evaluation review for solar PV installation

Improved health benefits for LAUSD students, 80% of which come from disadvantaged communities
