
LOUISVILLE, KY: Launching a Self-Financed Energy Management Program

Louisville Metro Government (LMG) has saved more than \$1.5 million and reduced building energy use by nearly 10% through new energy management initiatives including utility billing analysis and building performance audits.



Switched 260 LMG utility accounts to more cost-effective utility rates (or closed them entirely), saving more than \$160,000 annually







following utility billing analysis and building audits

Implemented setback scheduling across 900,000 square feet of facilities, reducing energy usage by up to 30% in scheduled buildings

Made its Energy Innovation Fund permanent moving demonstrated cost savings to a capital fund to finance future projects
