



UNIVERSITY OF VIRGINIA: UVA Sustainable Labs Program

The University of Virginia (UVA) implemented a Sustainable Labs Program to increase energy savings in intensive lab buildings, enhance safety features, and promote engagement with UVA's research community, decreasing CO₂e by more than 20%, energy use by almost 20%, and annual costs by around \$5 million.



Fully implemented Sustainable Labs in two research buildings and carried out targeted upgrades, lighting retrofits, and ventilation risk assessments



Designed and implemented specialized outreach programs, such as Green Labs Certification and the International Laboratory Freezer Challenge





Critical for UVA achieving carbon neutrality by 2030 and fossil fuel-free by 2050 as labs account for one-third of total energy use on campus
