The House Energy & Environment Committee Report (05/20/21) and the House Appropriations Committee Report (05/21/21) include amendments to the bill, however, Legislative Council Staff and JBC Staff agree that the committee amendments do not change the fiscal impact of the bill.

*Technical note: There is a technical error in Table 2 (pg. 3) of the Fiscal Note dated May 17, 2021. The personal services costs shown in the table are overstated. The personal services costs for the FTE identified in the Fiscal Note are \$67,792. The total required appropriation, inclusive of personal services costs, operating expenses, and capital outlay costs is \$75,342 General Fund. Legislative Council Staff and JBC Staff agree that \$75,342 General Fund is the correct appropriation for implementation of this bill.

Amendment Description

Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriation clause that provides \$75,342 General Fund to the Department of Personnel for FY 2021-22. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 0.9 FTE.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2021-22 based on the March 2021 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The budget package includes a set aside of \$48.0 million General Fund for bills that require General Fund appropriations for FY 2021-22. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$75,342 for FY 2021-22, reducing the \$48.0 million set aside by the same amount.
