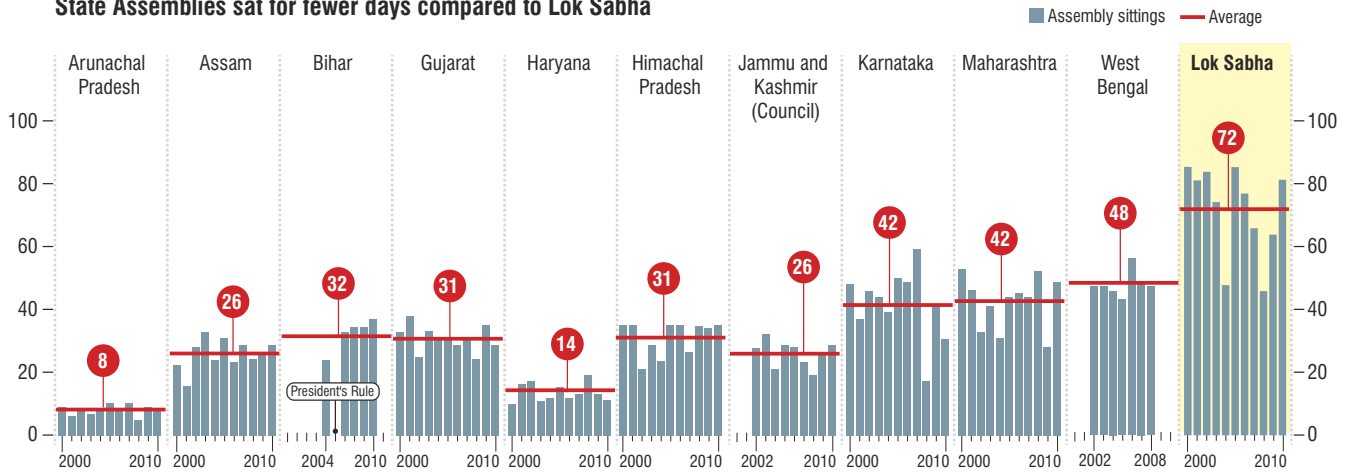
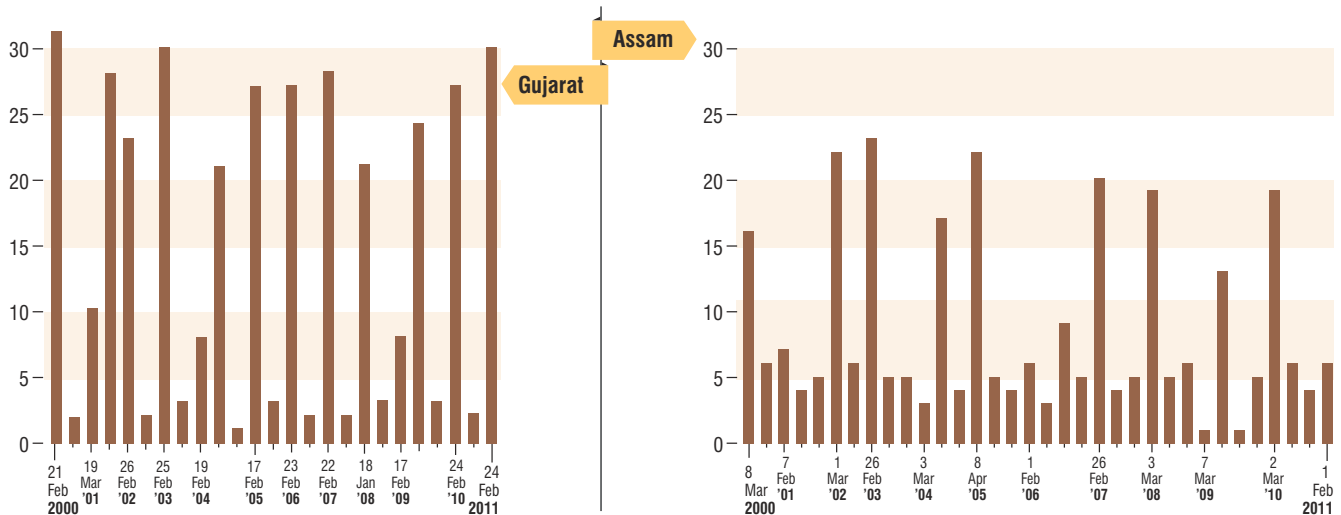


Data from State Assemblies: Some trends

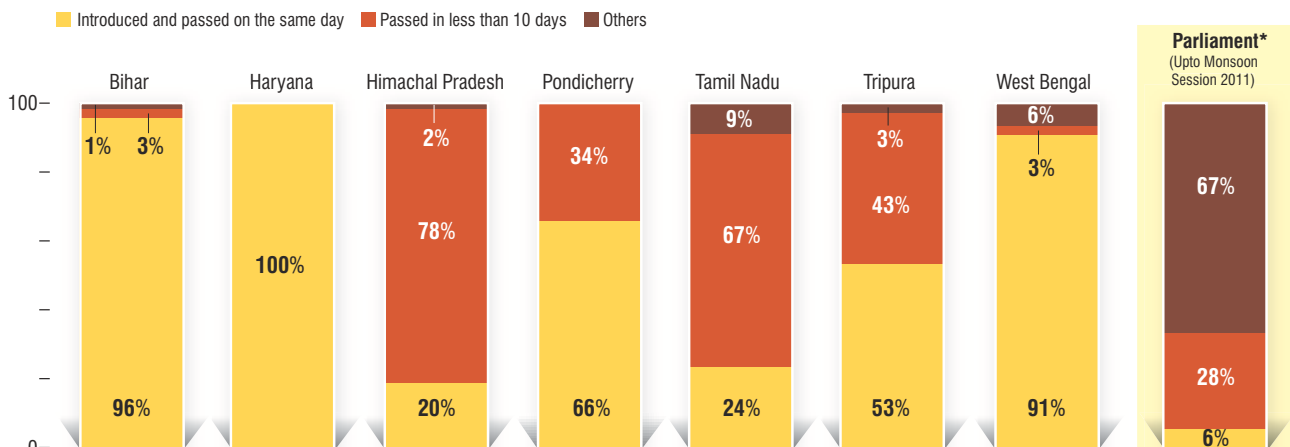
State Assemblies sat for fewer days compared to Lok Sabha



Except the Budget Session, most sessions in State Assemblies often last less than a week



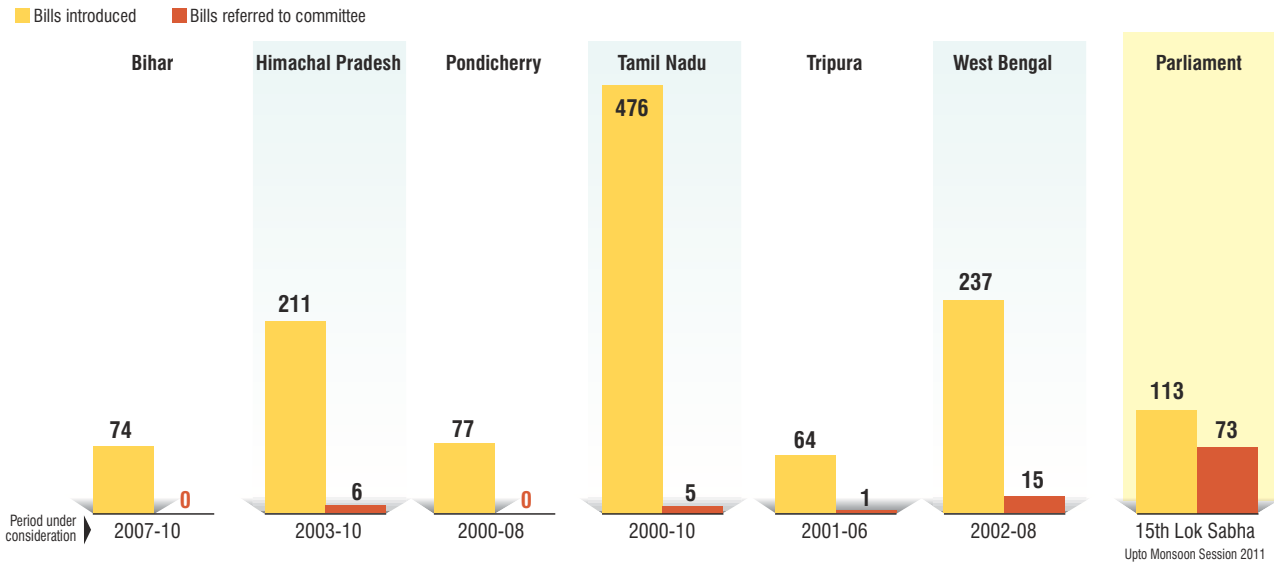
More than 90% of Bills in West Bengal, Bihar and Haryana were introduced and passed on the same day



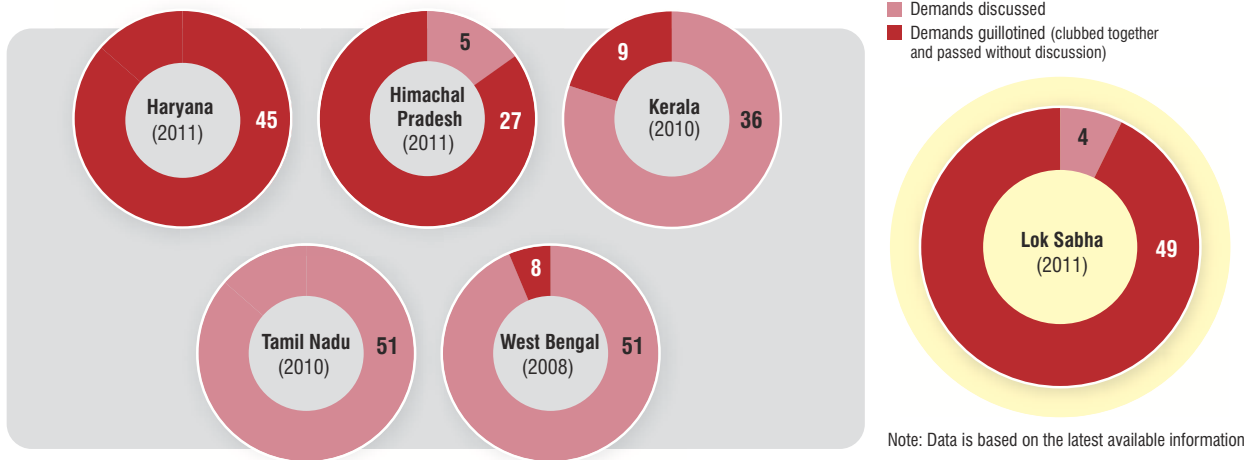

*Time period between introduction and passage by the first House (i.e. the House of introduction); On an average, a Bill takes about 4 months to be passed in the first House in Parliament

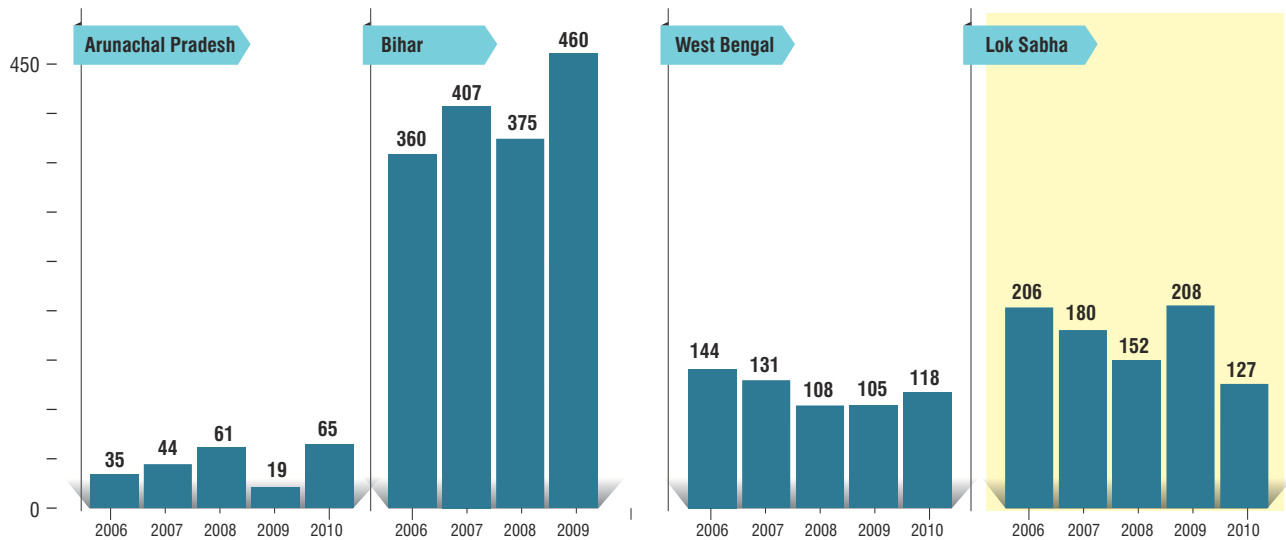
Very few Bills in State Assemblies are scrutinized by Committees
