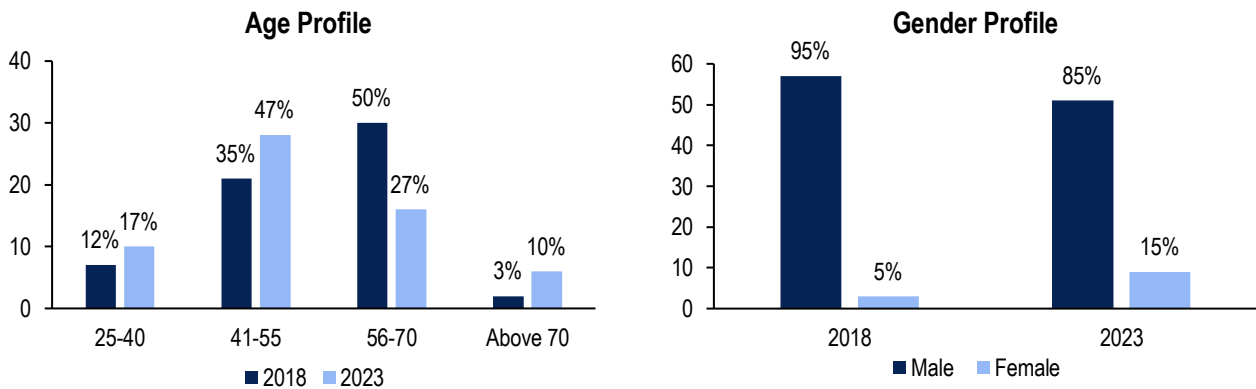
## Profile of the 13<sup>th</sup> Tripura Legislative Assembly

The results of the elections to the 13<sup>th</sup> Tripura Legislative Assembly were declared on March 2, 2023. There are 60 assembly seats in the state. In this note, we analyse data on the profile of the incoming Members of Legislative Assembly (MLAs) and compare it with the previous Assembly.

### Bharatiya Janata Party has the majority with 32 seats; Tipra Motha wins 13 seats

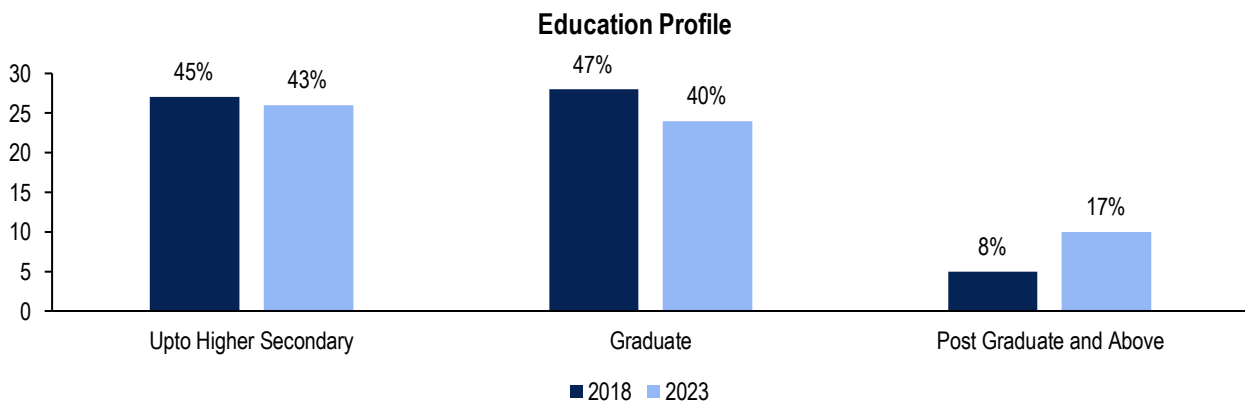

### Number of younger MLAs increase; number of women MLAs tripled from 3 to 9



- The incoming Assembly is younger in comparison to the outgoing Assembly, with 63% of MLAs below the age of 55. In the outgoing Assembly, this proportion was 47%.
