Notes

- New York is home to seven of the 20 counties with the highest percentage of speakers of Albanian. Michigan and Illinois are each home to three, Connecticut and Massachusetts have two apiece.
- Outside of Pinellas County, Florida, all of the 20 counties with the most speakers of Albanian are located in the northeast or Great Lakes.
- Albanian is the 11th most common language spoken in Michigan and the 14th most common language spoken in Connecticut.
- Albanian is the fourth most common language spoken at home in Cumberland County, Ill. and Iroquois County, Ill., and the fifth most common language in Jefferson County, Wis.
- In the United States, 1 of every 3,300 people age five and older speaks Albanian at home. In Connecticut, this figure is 1 in 628 people, while in New York, 1 in 666 residents is an Albanian speaker.
- Within the counties, Richmond County, N.Y. has the greatest rate of Albanian speakers (1 in every 108 residents), followed by Macomb County, Mich. (1 in every 123 residents) and Bronx County, N.Y. (1 in every 187 residents).
