Notes

- Hawaii is home to four of the top six counties with the highest percentage of Bisayan speakers. Within the top 20, California places seven counties, Hawaii four, Michigan and Florida two apiece.
- Bisayan is the 17th most common language spoken in Hawaii and the 45th most common language spoken in Nevada.
- Bisayan is the ninth most common language spoken at home in Columbia County, Fla., and the fifth most common language in Kauai County, Hawaii.
- In the United States, 1 of every 16,585 people age five and older speaks Bisayan at home. In Hawaii, this figure is 1 in 635 people, while in Nevada, 1 in 4,073 residents is a Bisayan speaker.
- Within the counties, Honolulu County, Hawaii has the greatest rate of Bisayan speakers (1 in every 550 residents), followed by Kauai County, Hawaii (1 in every 683 residents) and San Joaquin County, Calif. (1 in every 817 residents).
