Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of speakers of Cheyenne, ten are located in Oklahoma, with five in Montana.
- Rosebud County, Mont. accounts for 30.6 of the Cheyenne speakers in the U.S. The percentage of the residents who speak Cheyenne is more than three times higher here than in any other county in the nation.
- Cheyenne is the sixth most common language spoken in Montana and the 29th (tied) most common language spoken in Wyoming.
- Cheyenne is the second most common language spoken at home in Rosebud County, Mont. and the third most common language in Big Horn County, Mont., Blaine County, Okla., Dewey County, Okla., and Roger Mills County, Okla.
- In the United States, 1 of every 113,092 people age five and older speaks Cheyenne at home. In Montana, this figure is 1 in 709 people, while in Oklahoma, 1 in 5,846 residents is a Cheyenne speaker.
- Within the counties, Rosebud County, Mont. has the greatest rate of Cheyenne speakers (1 in every 12 residents), followed by Big Horn County, Mont. (1 in every 41 residents) and Roger Mills County, Okla. (1 in every 63 residents).
