Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of Croatian speakers, four are located in Ohio and three in Indiana.
- Lake County, Ohio has more than double the percentage of Croatian speakers of any other county in the United States.
- Croatian is the 20th most common language spoken in the District of Columbia and the 22nd most common language spoken in Ohio.
- Croatian is the third most common language spoken at home in Lake County, Ohio, and the fourth most common language in Appanoose County, Iowa.
- In the United States, 1 of every 4,493 people age five and older speaks Croatian at home. In the District of Columbia, this figure is 1 in 1,078 people, while in New Jersey, 1 in 1,505 residents is a Croatian speaker.
- Within the counties, Lake County, Ohio has the greatest rate of Croatian speakers (1 in every 124 residents), followed by Plaquemines Parish, La. (1 in every 261 residents) and Bergen County, N.Y. (1 in every 283 residents).
