Notes

- Of the 15 counties where speakers of Keres were recorded, 10 are located in New Mexico.
- Cibola County, N.M. and Sandoval County, N.M. have more than 86 times and 50 times, respectively, the percentage of Keres speakers of the remaining counties in the United States.
- Keres is the fourth most common language spoken in New Mexico.
- Keres is the third most common language spoken at home in Cibola County, N.M. and Sandoval County, N.M., and the fifth most common language in San Juan County, N.M. and McKinley County, N.M.
- In the United States, 1 of every 23,395 people age five and older speaks Keres at home. In New Mexico, this figure is 1 in 164 people, while in Alaska, 1 in 23,157 residents is a Keres speaker.
- Within the counties, Cibola County, N.M. has the greatest rate of Keres speakers (1 in every 7.9 residents), followed by Sandoval County, N.M. (1 in every 13.5 residents) and Bernalillo County, N.M. (1 in every 685 residents).
