Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the great percentage of speakers of Macedonian, five are located in Ohio, four in Michigan, three each in Indiana, New Jersey and New York.
- Macedonian is the 19th most common language spoken in Indiana and the 28th most common language spoken in Michigan.
- Macedonian is the sixth most common language spoken at home in Fairfield County, Ohio and Lake County, Ind., and the seventh most common language in Shiawassee County, Mich.
- In the United States, 1 of every 13,690 people age five and older speaks Macedonian at home. In Michigan, this figure is 1 in 1,852 people, while in Indiana, 1 in 2,476 residents is a Macedonian speaker.
- Within the counties, Lake County, Ind. has the greatest rate of Macedonian speakers (1 in every 248 residents), followed by Macomb County, Mich. (1 in every 308 residents) and Bergen County, N.J. (1 in every 566 residents).
