Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of speakers of Malay, Oklahoma and the Washington, D.C. metropolitan area are home three apiece.
- Malay is the 41st (tied) most common language spoken in Wyoming, the 42nd most common language spoken in Hawaii, and the 44th (tied) most common language spoken in Montana.
- Malay is the 10th most common language spoken at home in LaPlata County, Colo.
- In the United States, 1 of every 24,590 people age five and older speaks Malay at home. In Hawaii, this figure is 1 in 6,129 people, while in the District of Columbia, 1 in 8,987 residents is a Malay speaker.
- Within the counties, Athens County, Ohio has the greatest rate of Malay speakers (1 in every 983 residents), followed by Story County, Iowa (1 in every 1,162 residents) and Albany County, Wyo. (1 in every 1,206 residents).
