Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of Nepali speakers, Nebraska, Virginia and Colorado boast three each.
- Queens County, N.Y. has more than double the Nepali speakers of any other county in the United States.
- Nepali is the 28th most common language spoken in Nebraska and the 43rd (tie) most common language spoken in South Dakota.
- In the United States, 1 of every 24,498 people age five and older speaks Nepali at home. In Nebraska, this figure is 1 in 5,226 people, while in the District of Columbia, 1 in 8,296 residents is a Nepali speaker.
- Within the counties, Sarpy County, Neb. has the greatest rate of Nepali speakers (1 in every 1,181 residents), followed by Blue Earth County, Minn. (1 in every 1,315 residents) and Arlington County, Va. (1 in every 1,487 residents).
