## Notes

- Marshall County, Iowa has nearly twice the percentage of residents speaking Nilotic than any other county in the United States.
- Of the 15 counties where speakers of Nilotic were recorded, four are in Minnesota and three in Iowa.
- Nilotic is the 23rd most common language spoken in Nebraska and the 30th most common language spoken in Iowa and South Dakota.
- Nilotic is the fifth most common language spoken at home in Marshall County, Iowa and Orange County, N.Y., and the sixth most common language in Pottawattamie County, Iowa.
- In the United States, 1 of every 87,604 people age five and older speaks Nilotic at home. In Nebraska, this figure is 1 in 4,308 people, while in Iowa, 1 in 5,825 residents is a Nilotic speaker.
- Within the counties, Marshall County, Iowa has the greatest rate of Nilotic speakers (1 in every 523 residents), followed by Pottawattamie County, Iowa (1 in every 1,022 residents) and Minnehaha County, S.D. (1 in every 1,304 residents).
