Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of speakers of Pakistan, n.e.c., seven were located in New York and four each in New Jersey and Texas.
- Pakistan, n.e.c. is the 47th (tie) most common language spoken in Louisiana, the 48th most common language spoken in Texas, and the 51st most common language spoken in New York.
- In the United States, 1 of every 18,795 people age five and older speaks Pakistan, n.e.c. at home. In New York, this figure is 1 in 5,137 people, while in New Jersey, 1 in 6,137 residents is a Pakistan, n.e.c. speaker.
- Within the counties, Fort Bend County, Texas has the greatest rate of Pakistan, n.e.c. speakers (1 in every 1,109 residents), followed by San Joaquin County, Calif. (1 in every 1,297 residents) and Albany County, N.Y. (1 in every 1,633 residents).
