Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of speakers of Pampangan, 11 are located in California, including the top three and four of the top five. Only four of the top 20 counties were located east of the Mississippi River.
- Pampangan is the 36th most common language spoken in Hawaii, the 49th (tied) most common language spoken in Alaska and the 67th most common language spoken in California.
- In the United States, 1 of every 47,317 people age five and older speaks Pampangan at home. In Hawaii, this figure is 1 in 4,278 people, while in Alaska, 1 in 6,811 residents is a Pampangan speaker.
- Within the counties, Alameda County, Calif. has the greatest rate of Pampangan speakers (1 in every 1,432 residents), followed by San Mateo County, Calif. (1 in every 1,504 residents) and San Francisco County, Calif. (1 in every 2,042 residents).
