Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the highest percentage of Serbian speakers, Illinois and Ohio have four apiece.
- Lake County, Ind. has more than double the percentage of Serbian speakers of any other county in the United States.
- Cook County, Ill. is home to 17.7 percent of the Serbian speakers in the United States.
- Serbian is the 17th most common language spoken in Indiana and the 18th most common language spoken in Wisconsin.
- Serbian is the fourth most common language spoken at home in Lake County, Ind. and fifth most common language in Garland County, Ark.
- In the United States, 1 of every 5,782 people age five and older speaks Serbian at home. In Illinois, this figure is 1 in 1,070 people, while in Wisconsin, 1 in 1,784 residents is a Serbian speaker.
- Within the counties, Lake County, Ind. has the greatest rate of Serbian speakers (1 in every 174 residents), followed by Medina County, Ohio (1 in every 400 residents) and Hancock County, W.Va. (1 in every 475 residents).
