Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of speakers of Sindhi, five can be found in New Jersey and three each in New York and the Washington, D.C. metropolitan area.
- Sindhi is the 57th most common language spoken in New Hampshire and the 62nd most common language spoken in Georgia.
- In the United States, 1 of every 33,573 people age five and older speaks Sindhi at home. In New Jersey, this figure is 1 in 9,465 people, while in New Hampshire, 1 in 13,646 residents is a Sindhi speaker.
- Within the counties, Champaign County, Ill. has the greatest rate of Sindhi speakers (1 in every 1,878 residents), followed by Arlington County, Va. (1 in every 2,549 residents) and Fort Bend County, Texas (1 in every 2,727 residents).
