Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the greatest percentage of Syriac speakers, eight are located in Michigan and six in California.
- The percentage of Syriac speakers in Stanislaus County, Calif., Oakland County, Mich., and Macomb County, Mich. are significantly above the percentage of any other county in the U.S.
- Oakland County, Mich. is home to 23.3 percent of the Syriac speakers in the United States.
- Syriac is the eighth most common language spoken in Michigan and the 18th most common language spoken in Illinois.
- Syriac is the third most common language spoken at home in Oakland County, Mich. and Stanislaus County, Calif.
- In the United States, 1 of every 4,172 people age five and older speaks Syriac at home. In Michigan, this figure is 1 in 358 people, while in Illinois, 1 in 872 residents is a Syriac speaker.
- Within the counties, Stanislaus County, Calif. has the greatest rate of Syriac speakers (1 in every 65 residents), followed by Oakland County, Mich. (1 in every 76 residents) and Macomb County, Mich. (1 in every 94 residents).
