Notes

- Of the 20 counties with the highest percentage of speakers of Turkish, five are located in New York, five in the Washington, D.C. metropolitan area and four in New Jersey.
- Turkish is the 24th most common language spoken in Rhode Island, 26th most common in New Jersey and 27th most common in the District of Columbia
- Turkish is the fifth most common language spoken in Lauderdale County, Ala. and Woodford County, Ill. and the sixth most common in Salem County, N.J.
- In the United States, 1 of every 3,539 people age five and older speaks Turkish at home. In New Jersey, this figure is 1 in 804 people, while in New York, 1 in 1,079 residents is a Turkish speaker.
- Within the counties, Fairfax city, Va. has the greatest concentration of Turkish speakers (1 in every 197 residents), followed by Passaic County, N.J. (1 in every 200 residents) and Bergen County, N.J. (1 in every 307 residents).
