Languages in Oregon

- Multnomah County's 89 languages represented the 19th highest number recorded in any county in the United States. Other Oregon counties that were highly ranked included: Washington County (t-59), Lane County (t-164), Clackamas County (t-181) and Marion County (t-204).
- Oregon has the highest percentage of speakers of Romanian and Romany in the United States. The Beaver State also ranks second in the percentage of Mayan language, Micronesian, Oto-Manguen, Palau, Sahaptian and Trukese speakers and third in the percentage of Marshallese, Miao-Yao/Mien and Ukrainian speakers.
- Multnomah County has the second highest percentage of Russian speakers of any county in the nation. Other counties that rank highly in a given language include: Multnomah (seventh, Miao-Yao/Mien), Marion County (ninth, Russian), and Multnomah County (10th, Vietnamese).
