Language Rankings in America's Counties

The tables below list languages in which selected counties placed among the nation's leaders in terms of percentage of the population speaking a given language at home. For example, Alameda County, Calif. had the nation's highest percentage of Pampangan speakers of the 3,141 counties in the United States. Also given is the number of speakers of the language in the county (940 Pampangan speakers in Alameda County, Calif.) and the percentage of the county's residents speaking that language (0.070%). The number in parentheses indicates the county's rank in terms of the *number of speakers* of that language. In the case of Alameda County, it also ranks as the county with the most Pampangan speakers.
