GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

At this time, Habele is only accepting scholarship applications from students seeking to renew an existing tuition scholarship. Unsolicited new applications will not be considered and those providing such applications will not be contacted.¹

Habele will announce scholarship winners no later than the first week of August. Every renewal and solicited applicant student who submitted an application that reached Habele before June 30th will receive a post card addressed to the home address listed on their application form indicating whether or not they will be awarded a scholarship. Due to the high volume of applicants, there will be no notifications or confirmations through email. If there is a mailing error due to illegibility or inaccuracy of the mailing address as indicated on the form, the applicant will not receive any contact from Habele. Applicants and renewal applicants who sent materials that reach Habele after June 30th will not be contacted.

Checks for scholarship recipients will be mailed directly to the school listed on the applicant form of winners on <u>August 1st</u>. These are non-transferable and any remaining portion of tuition owed is entirely the family's responsibility. Winners are required to provide Habele with report cards, letters, and photos during the school year. Habele must be notified immediately if the student leaves the school for any reason. It is the family's'—not the school's- responsibility to provide Habele with these materials.

In making scholarship decisions Habele is limited by its ability to raise funds. Habele is an all-volunteer charity that receives no support from the US or FSM governments. All revenues are gathered through private donations from individuals in the US and Europe. Volunteers administer the application process. A separate volunteer review board makes scholarships decisions and only considers completed on time application packets.

Since 2006, Habele has received and considered an average of 10 completed on-time applications for each scholarship awarded. The number of scholarships awarded is entirely a function of the volume of donations Habele receives. Please set your expectations accordingly.

¹ Only in special instances would Habele, working directly with a school headmaster or development worker, consider contacting a family and **inviting them** to apply for a new scholarship. Family or relatives' request(s) for special considerations will be treated as unsolicited applications and ignored. Because Habele is a an-volunteer charity with virtually no overhead, every effort is made to reduce the time donated for processing of applications and correspondences unlikely to result in scholarships.
