

ASHRAE SUPPORT FOR PERFORMING LITERATURE REVIEWS IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF RTARS AND WORK STATEMENTS

ASHRAE recognizes the importance of and difficulty in obtaining background literature necessary to develop good RTARS and work statements. In support of these development efforts, ASHRAE can offer the following services and support for obtaining literature reviews:

1. Free Access to Relevant ASHRAE Publications: The ASHRAE On-Line Bookstore contains a database of ASHRAE Symposium, Technical, and HVAC&R Research papers, Technical Reports from ASHRAE projects, ASHRAE standards, etc. Preparers of RTARS and Work Statements can use the keyword or author search features at the Online Bookstore (<http://www.ashrae.org/publications>) to identify and view abstracts of relevant publications. Upon approval of MORTS, ASHRAE will provide RTAR and Work Statement preparers with electronic copies of any literature that provides important background in the development and/or implementation of research projects for ASHRAE.
2. One-Day Pass to On-Line Engineering Databases: The Engineering Village (<http://www.engineeringvillage.com/>) contains a number of on-line databases for publications in all aspects of engineering. This includes the Compendex database, which covers most of the journal publications that would be relevant to ASHRAE activities. Upon approval of MORTS, ASHRAE will cover the cost of a one-day pass to on-line Engineering Village databases. This service will allow RTAR and Work Statement preparers to identify and order relevant publications. For approved users, ASHRAE will reimburse costs up to \$150 for a one-day pass and electronic downloads of relevant papers.
3. Support for Library Searches: Many libraries provide support services for performing database searches. Typical hourly rates for these services are \$40-50. Upon approval of MORTS, ASHRAE will reimburse costs for library searches of up to \$200.
