Congratulations on receiving what we consider to be a "clean" audit from the Corporation for Public Broadcasting's (CPB) Office of Inspector General (OIG)!

Considering that the audit reviewed over \$2.6 million in non-federal financial support, compliance with the Certification of Eligibility, General Provisions and the Communications Act of 1934, 47 U.S.C. § 396, et, seq., the audit results are quite impressive. While the OIG points out that WDCB-FM did not meet one of the four open meeting requirements concerning quarterly on-air announcement, CPB is in the process of reviewing that requirement and others, and expects to remove it in the near future.

We appreciate the efforts and resources you have taken to ensure compliance with the grant terms and the Communications Act. Well done!
