Tribal HUD-VASH Leasing Performance Report-Instructional Guide

The Leasing Performance Report (LPR) is a formatted document to assist tribal HUD-VASH grant recipients to input renewal data. Grantees applying for renewal funding must fill out this document and include an electronic copy with their renewal application. The renewal funding data should reflect actual rental data based on the leasing period of April 1, 2023 — March 31, 2024. Please use the instructions to complete the LPR.

It is the recipient's responsibility to ensure all data is entered correctly and that the monthly RAP reflects the actual monthly RAP paid by the recipient.
Total RAP	The annual RAP contribution of Tribal HUD-VASH funding during the leasing period of April 1, 2023 — March 31, 2024.	The total RAP column auto- calculates the total RAP payment for the leasing period based on the monthly RAP multiplied by the months leased. It is the recipient's responsibility to ensure all data is entered correctly and

that the Total RAP reflects the
actual RAP paid by the
recipient during the leasing
period.
