**Short description:** Passengers and crew of the flight FSF213K from Milano Linate (LIML)

to Saint Tropez La Môle (LFTZ) observed during the cruise phase smoke in the cabin (white/grey, acidic odour). Oxygen masks were donned, emergency descent initiated and emergency was declared for a diversion to Genova (LIMJ). The crew landed in Genova approximately 8 minutes after the initial smoke detection and performed emergency shutdown and evacuation. Every occupant was able to walk out of the air-

plane.
