## Notification

We inform you about an accident of an aircraft registered in Latvia which occurred in Latvia.

**Place, date and time:** 4 km from Riga Intl. Airport (EVRA), 19 June 2024, 07:54 UTC

### Short description:

The aircraft was providing parachute jumps at the EVLI airfield. Due to extremely adverse weather conditions, the pilot decided to fly to land at the Riga Airport (alternate airfield). Approximately 3 NM from RWY18, the pilot informed the Riga ATC that he was making an emergency landing because he had run out of fuel. After landing ground roll the aircraft came to rest in a ditch with water. The pilot was not injured, the passenger (parachutist) on board was seriously injured and taken to hospital.
