Excellency,

Australia and Argentina, as the Co-facilitators to lead consultations on the work of the General Assembly and the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, have held open meetings with the membership, the UN system and other stakeholders on 8 February, 6 March and 11 April 2017.

There has been active participation from a wide range of delegations, reflecting the importance of this topic. Many concrete ideas and practical proposals have been put forward, though some need further discussion in order to be considered acceptable to all Member States.

Our intention is to continue our consultations and present a report to you in June 2017. Unless member states specifically require it, we do not expect to convene a further open meeting until June, prior to finalising and submitting our report. Of course we remain available for meetings with any country or group of countries to discuss specific issues before that time. Any Member State or stakeholder is also welcome to send through comments and suggestions in writing before 15 May, to inform the preparation of our final report.
